

Subject: Confirmation of Partnership between WFUNA and Alenra Global

Geneva, 13 December 2025

To Whom It May Concern,

The World Federation of United Nations Associations (WFUNA) confirms that we have entered into a formal Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Alenra Global for the delivery of the Advanced Training Program: ALENRA (ATP: ALENRA). WFUNA recognizes ATP: ALENRA as a WFUNA educational initiative that supports our mission to promote knowledge of the United Nations, its principles, and its work.

ATP: ALENRA is a high-level, immersive training program with a focus on the UN system and multilateral diplomacy. It serves advanced students and young professionals who seek an academic and professional development experience in Geneva. The program may include sessions with UN agencies, diplomats, and international experts, subject to availability. The program is not an internship and does not include internship placement or an internship component.\


For the Spring 2026 session, WFUNA and Alenra Global plan to hold the program in Geneva, Switzerland. The session is proposed for a five-business-day period in April 2026; WFUNA and Alenra Global will confirm the exact dates by mutual agreement no later than 90 days before the start of the session.

Alenra Global pre-screens and selects participants for each session. Participants must also be enrolled in, or otherwise formally linked to, Alenra Global. Alenra Global does not recruit participants from the general public, which supports selectivity and institutional alignment.

WFUNA retains full authority over the curriculum, content, and delivery of ATP: ALENRA. Upon successful completion, participants receive a certificate of completion issued by WFUNA. WFUNA supports this collaboration as part of our educational outreach and mission-driven work. The program aims to strengthen understanding of UN values, global citizenship, and multilateral cooperation.
